

RV Maintenance Checklist

Before Leaving The Campground

External

- **Jacks** – locked up or stowed
- **Chocks** – removed and stowed
- **Lights** – ensure they are working properly
- **Rig** – remove from levelers
- **Tires** – check tire pressure
- **Awnings** – rolled up and secured
- **Heaters** – water and gas heaters off
- **Chairs** – put away
- **Satellite** – stowed
- **Hoses** – caps in place
- **Electric** – disconnect unnecessary wiring
- **Cable** – pack and stow power cables
- **Water Pressure** – remove regulator
- **Steps** – fold and stow
- **Compartments** – locked shut

Internal

- **Furnace** – turn off
- **Water pump** – turn off
- **Refrigerator** – clean out, turn off
- **Pilot lights** – turn off
- **Antenna** – lowered
- **Water heater** – turn off
- **Windows and vents** - closed
- **Cabinets** – closed and locked
- **Bathroom** – shower door closed, loose items put away
- **Entry door** – closed and locked
- **Trash cans** – emptied and stowed

Monthly

- **Generator** – run for 2 hours
- **Batteries** – topped off
- **Air conditioning** – vacuum vents
- **Engine** – check hoses and clamps
- **Fluid levels** – inspect fluid
- **Toolbox** – refill RV toolkit
- **Detectors** – test smoke and CO
- **Tires** – check pressure and sidewalls
- **Undercarriage** – look for cracks
- **Slide outs** - lubricate
- **Moisture seals** – check for cracks

Semi-Annual

- **Deep clean**
- **Wax**
- **Water heater** – check filter
- **Metals** – lubricate hitch, leveling jacks and steps
- **Damage** – exterior inspection

Annual

- **Log** – update maintenance log
- **Heating and cooling** – tune systems
- **Tires, belts, brakes, hoses** – inspect, tune, and repack wheel bearings
- **Propane** – inspect system
- **Seals** – inspect all seals including roof and vents
- **Detector batteries** – install new batteries in detectors
- **TV antenna** - lubricate
- **Radiator** – check coolant
