RV Winterizing Checklist

O **Park the camper.** Do this on a level surface and stabilize the tires using wheel chocks or leveling blocks. Some travelers prefer to jack their campers off the ground. If you have a motorized RV, park it with emergency brake engaged.

- O Clean the camper. Unpack valuables, get rid of any food crumbs.
 - Closets
 - Countertops
 - Cabinets
 - Oven and range

 - Remove and clean sheets, bedding and curtains.
 - Unplug the refrigerator and clean out the ice maker.
- O Wash and store sewer hose. Drain black and gray water tanks.
- O Winterize the plumbing system. Use antifreeze or compressed air
 - Flush and drain black and gray water tanks
 - Drain water heater
 - Drain freshwater system
 - Remove inline water filters
 - Check to see if water heater bypass is installed
 - Pump antifreeze throughout system
- O Disconnect Electronics. Including TV, stereo, small electronics, coffee makers, water pump, anything plugged into outlets. Disconnect batteries and store at room temperature if possible.
- O Turn Off Propane (LP). If you have portable tanks, remove them and cap the lines.
- O Change oil and add fuel stabilizer. Do this if parking your RV for more than 6 months. Additionally, add fuel stabilizer to your generator.
- Cover outside outlets.
- Seal door and window gaps.
- Inspect the roof for leaks.
- Clean the awning.
- O Cover your camper.
